

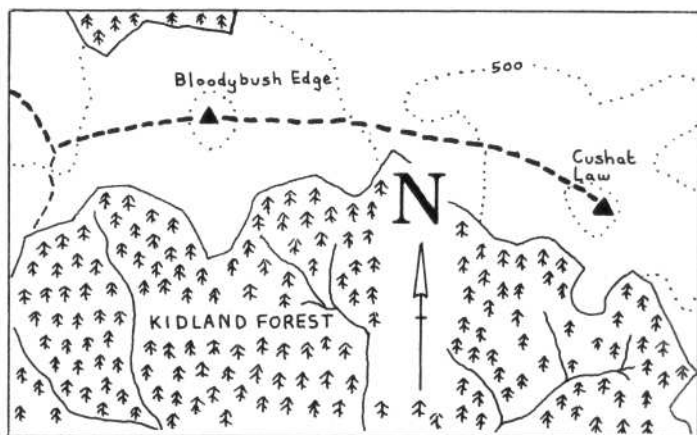
continues up the hillside. Just before reaching the forest strike left up the hill and follow the fence which leads unerringly to Bloodybush Edge, complete with standard concrete OS trig point by the fence junction. To the north lies The Cheviot and Hedgehope Hill.

CUSHAT LAW (*Wood-pigeon's Hill*)

The next section is an out and back, so follow the fence east to a col, where we saw two deer, then continue to the top of Cushat Law. From the hollowed out ancient cairn there are views to the east of the North Sea.

Return to Uswayford and cross back over the footbridge, then take the narrow path to the left of Usway Burn. Hopefully there will be a stile, but if not continue to the gate, then follow the improved bridleway which leads up through the forest to cross a forest road. The ascent continues though the trees to emerge into the open then veers right to join Clennel Street, a Roman Road and also former drove road, which leads over the moor to meet the Border Ridge at
